<u>Resolved objection</u> - The Parish Council reiterates its previous objection. The Council considers this to be overdevelopment of the village, especially in light of the planned Garden Village which is supposed to reduce excessive development. The developer's plans do not show other new developments already underway in the village. There is already a problem with drainage in Cumwhinton which is causing flooding in a number of properties. Until this is resolved there should be no further development permitted in the village. The proposed site and surrounding land are already waterlogged and unsuitable for building.
